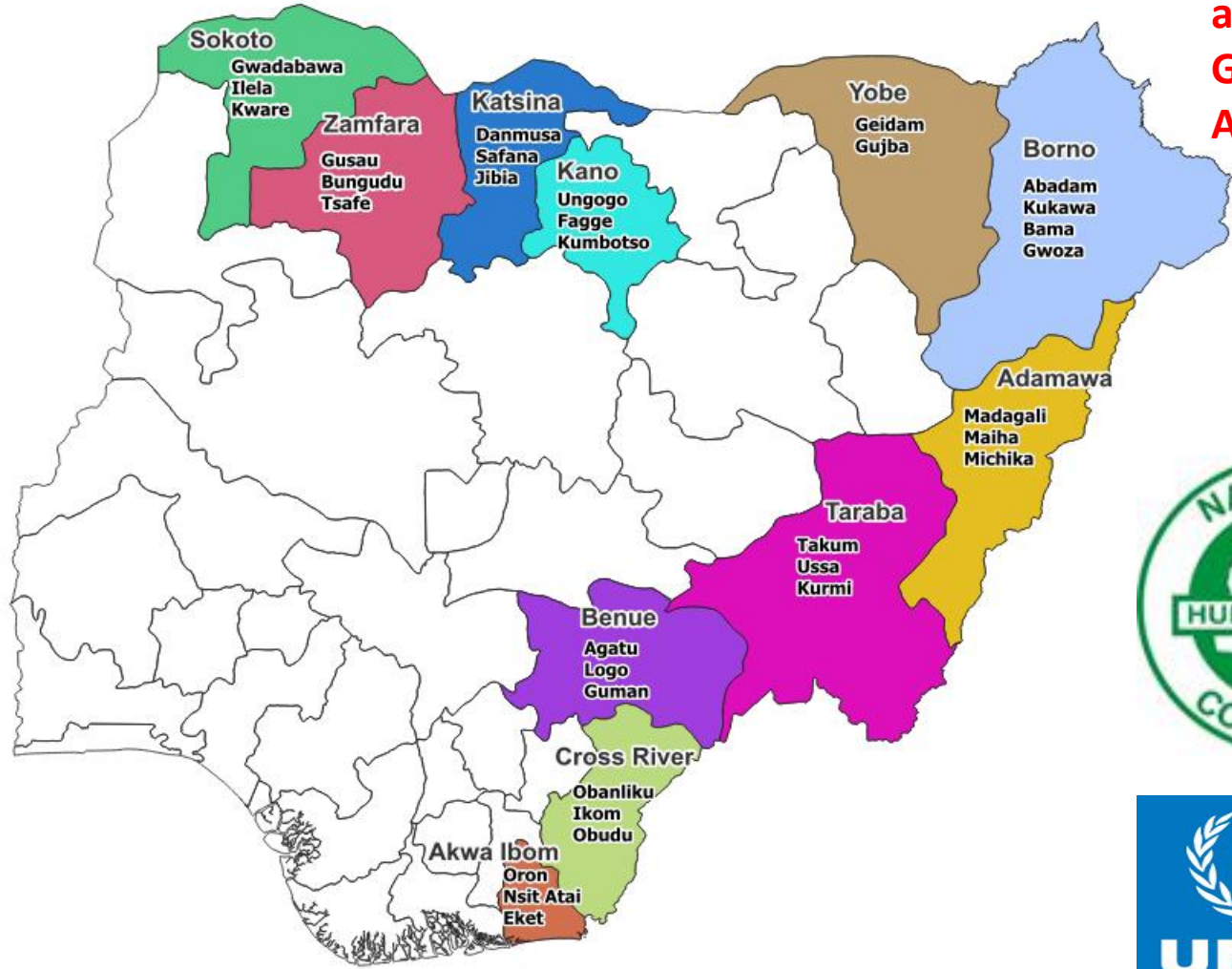

OBJECTIVE OF DASHBOARD

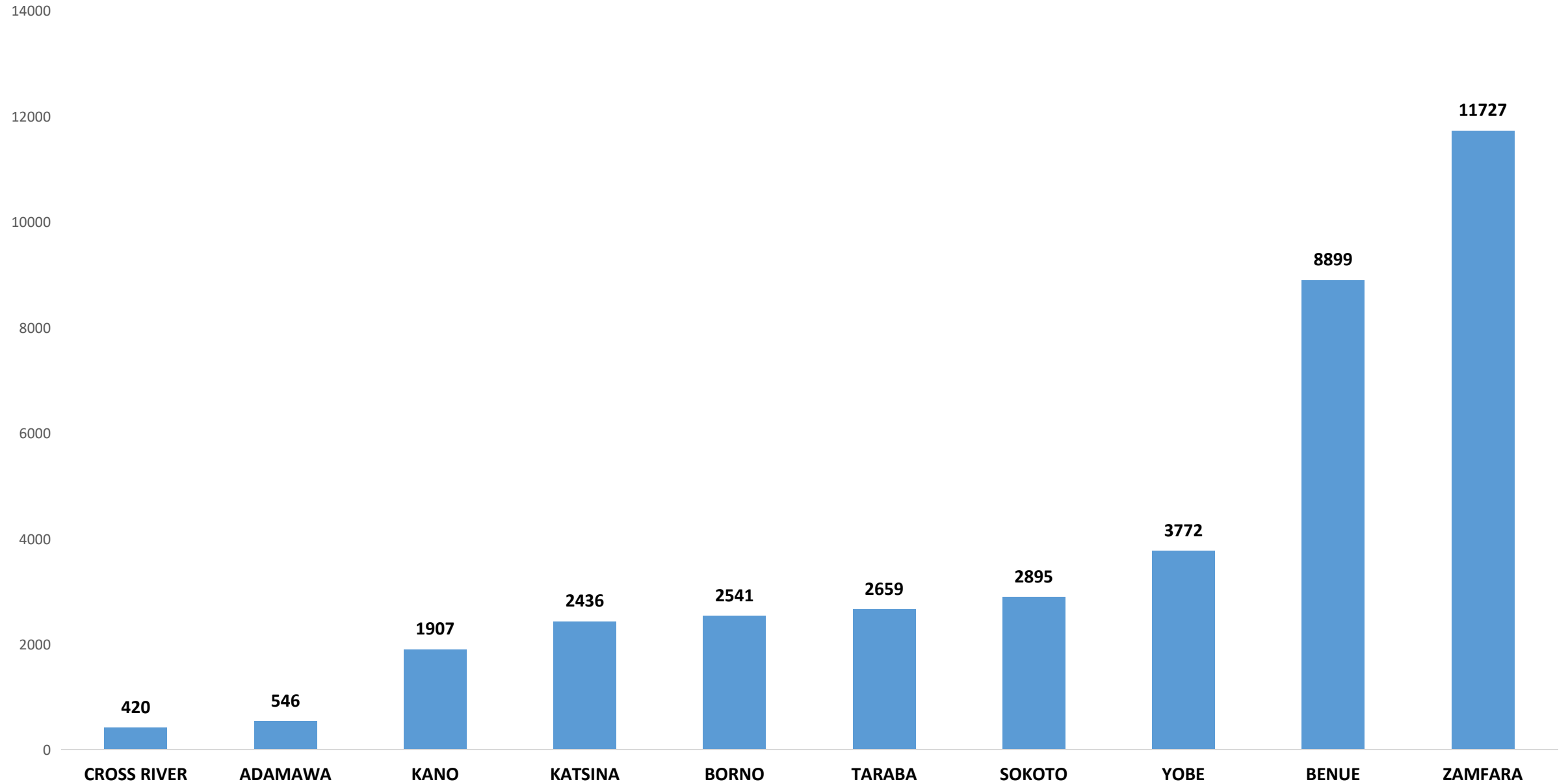

Aug – Sept 2025

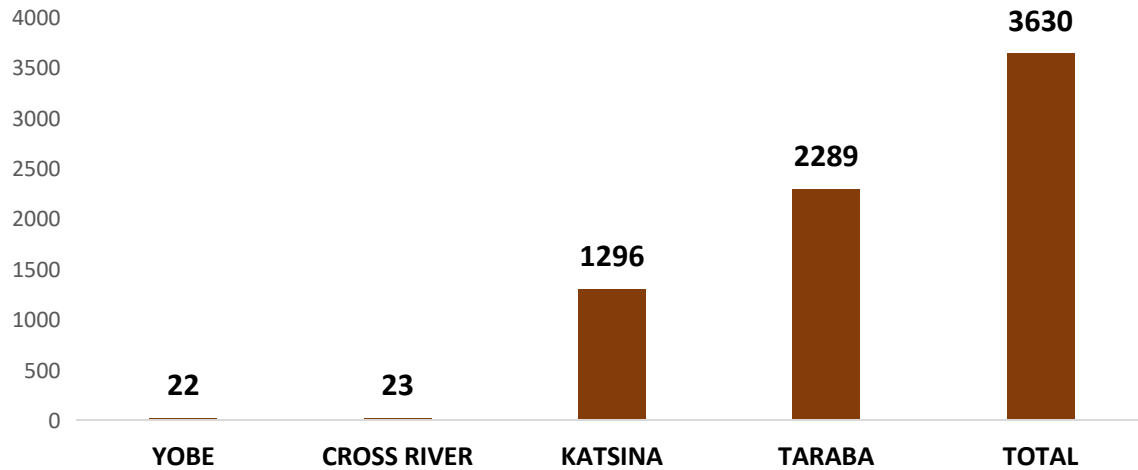


Gender & Household disaggregation of IDPs/FDPs Across Project States

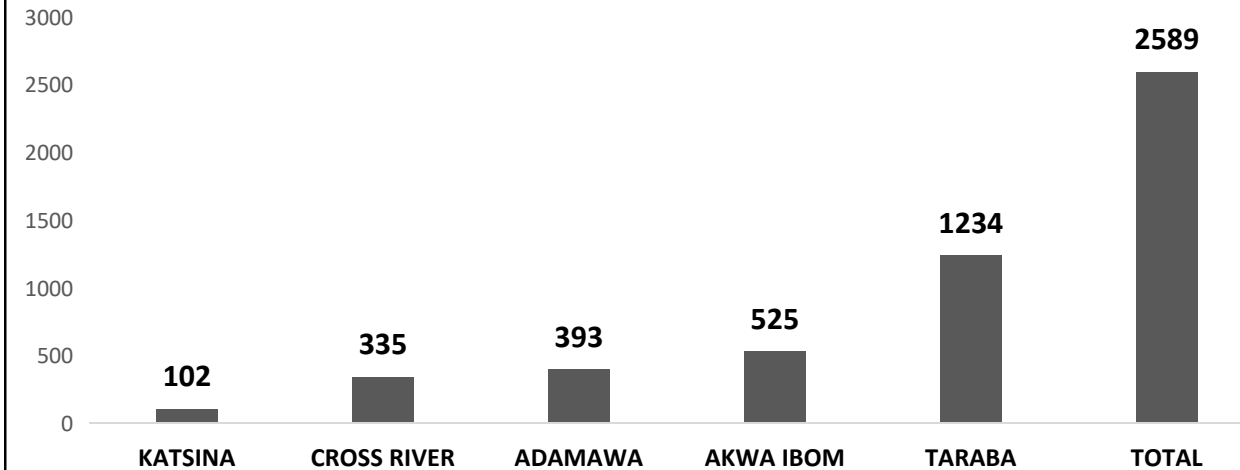

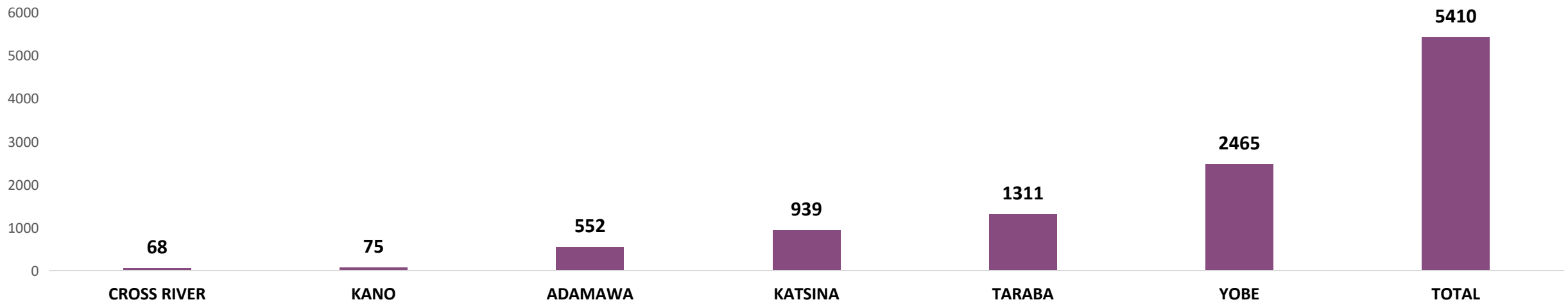
Total Asylum Seekers (Aug - Sept 2025)

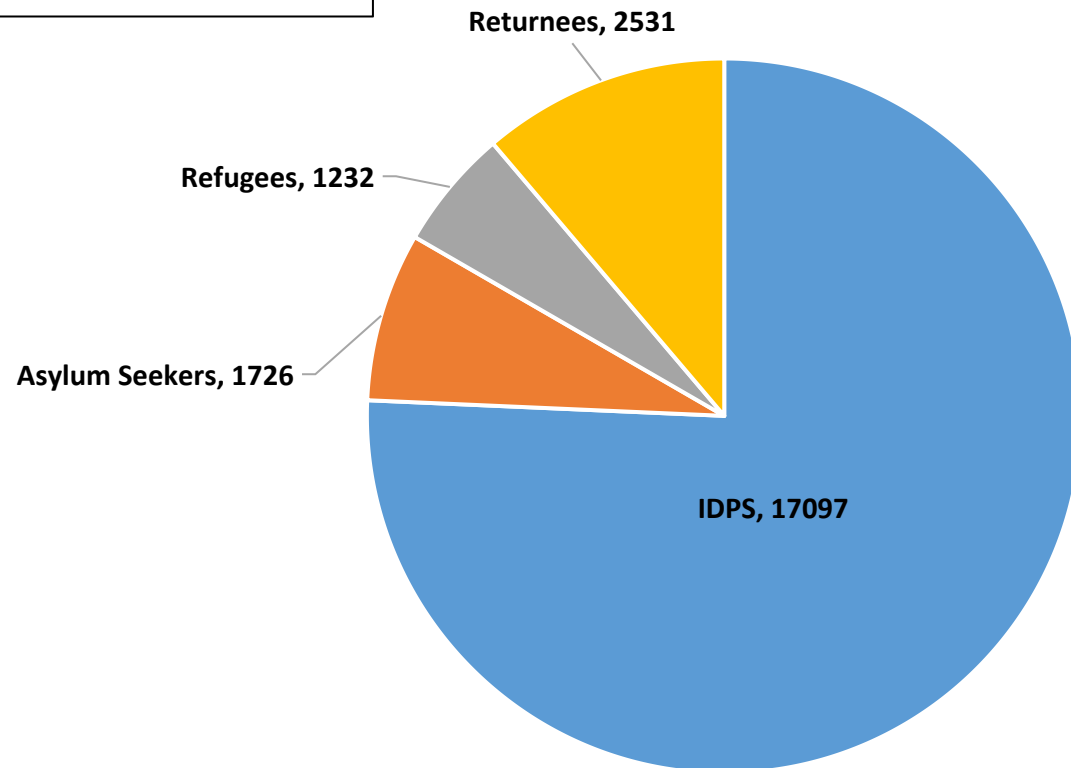


Total Gender Disaggregation of IDPs, Refugees, Asylum Seekers and Returnees (Aug - Sept 2025)

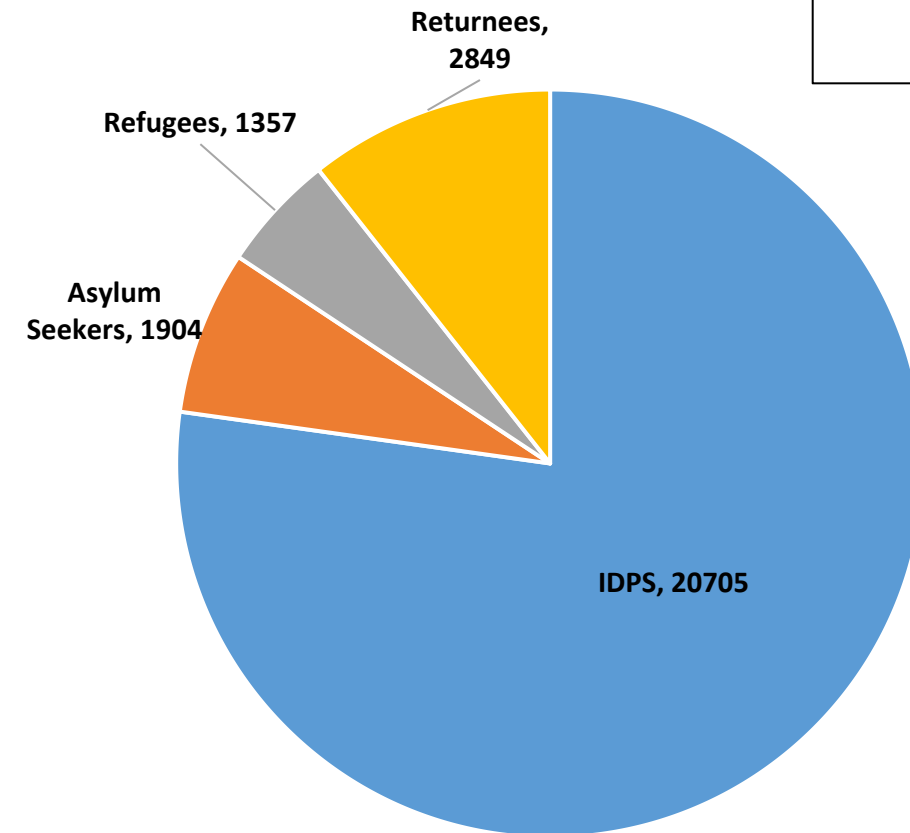

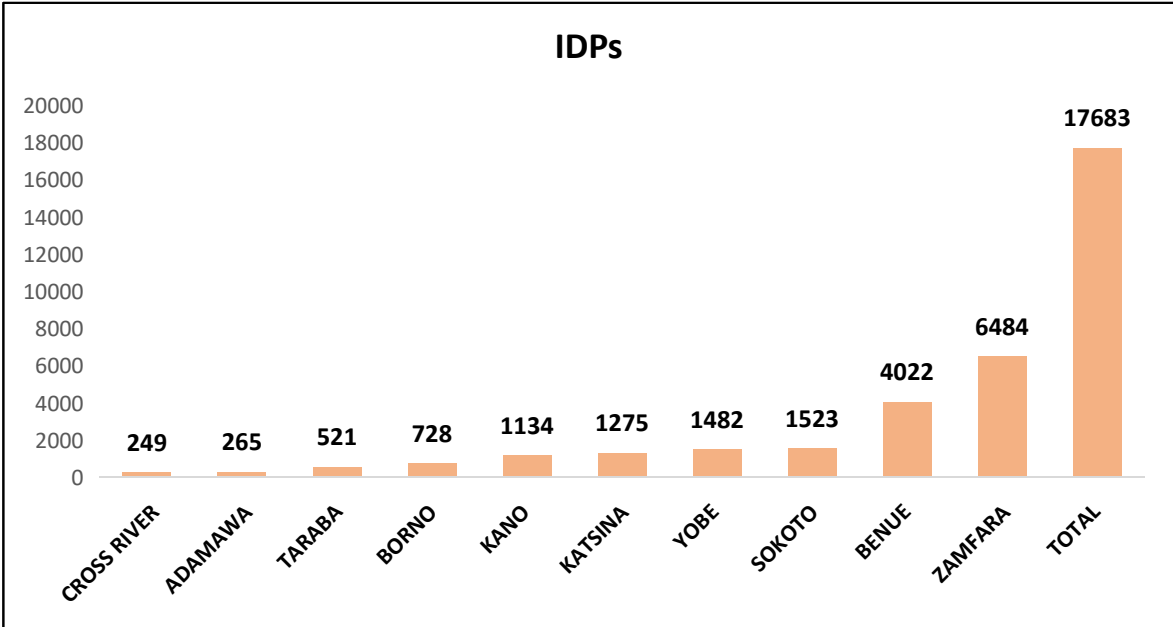

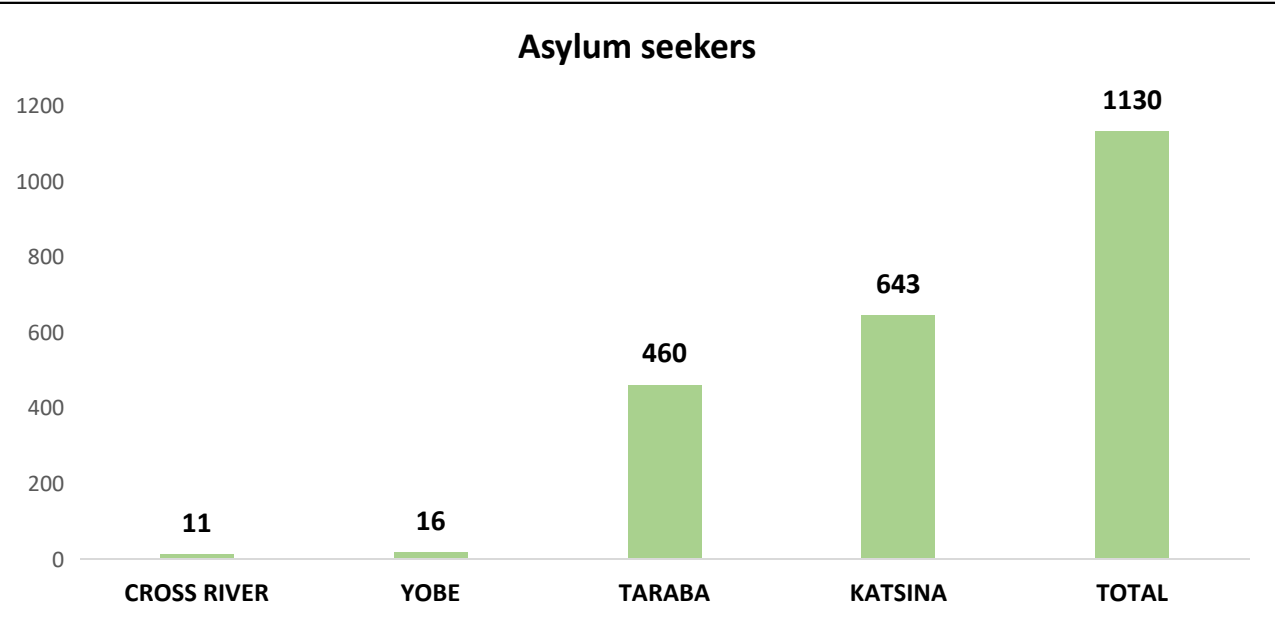

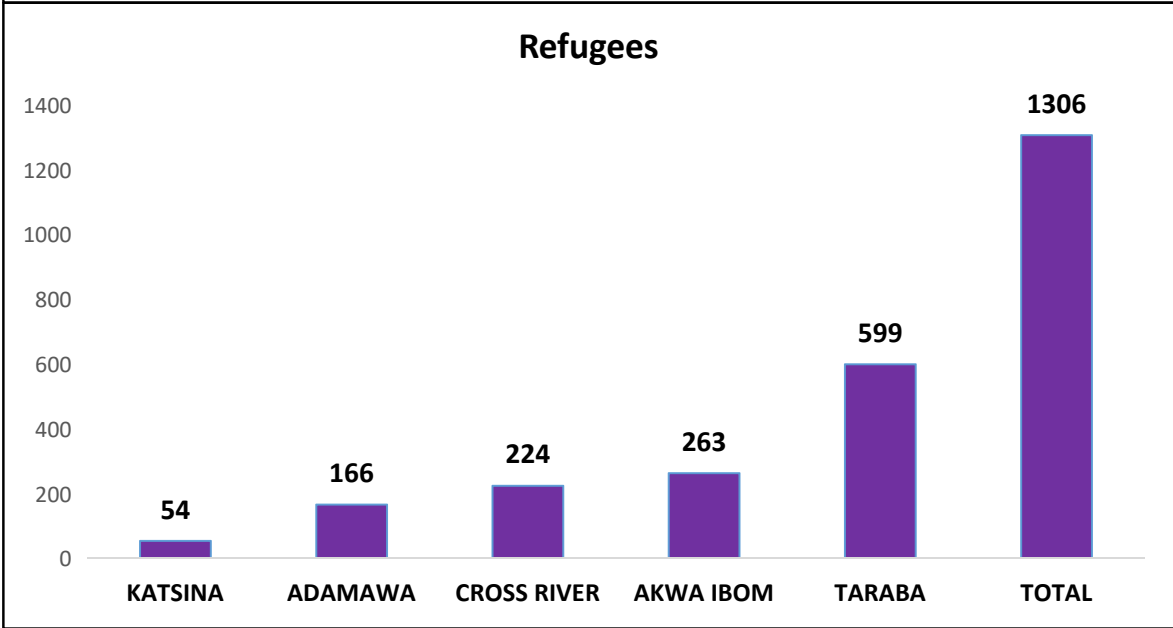

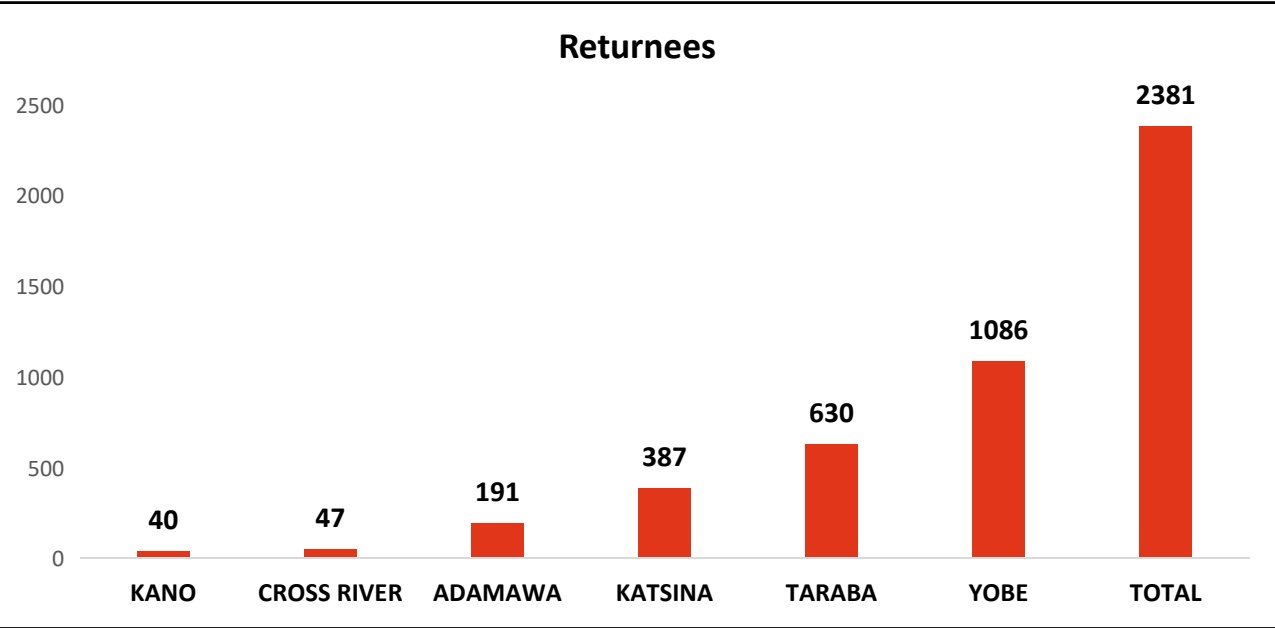

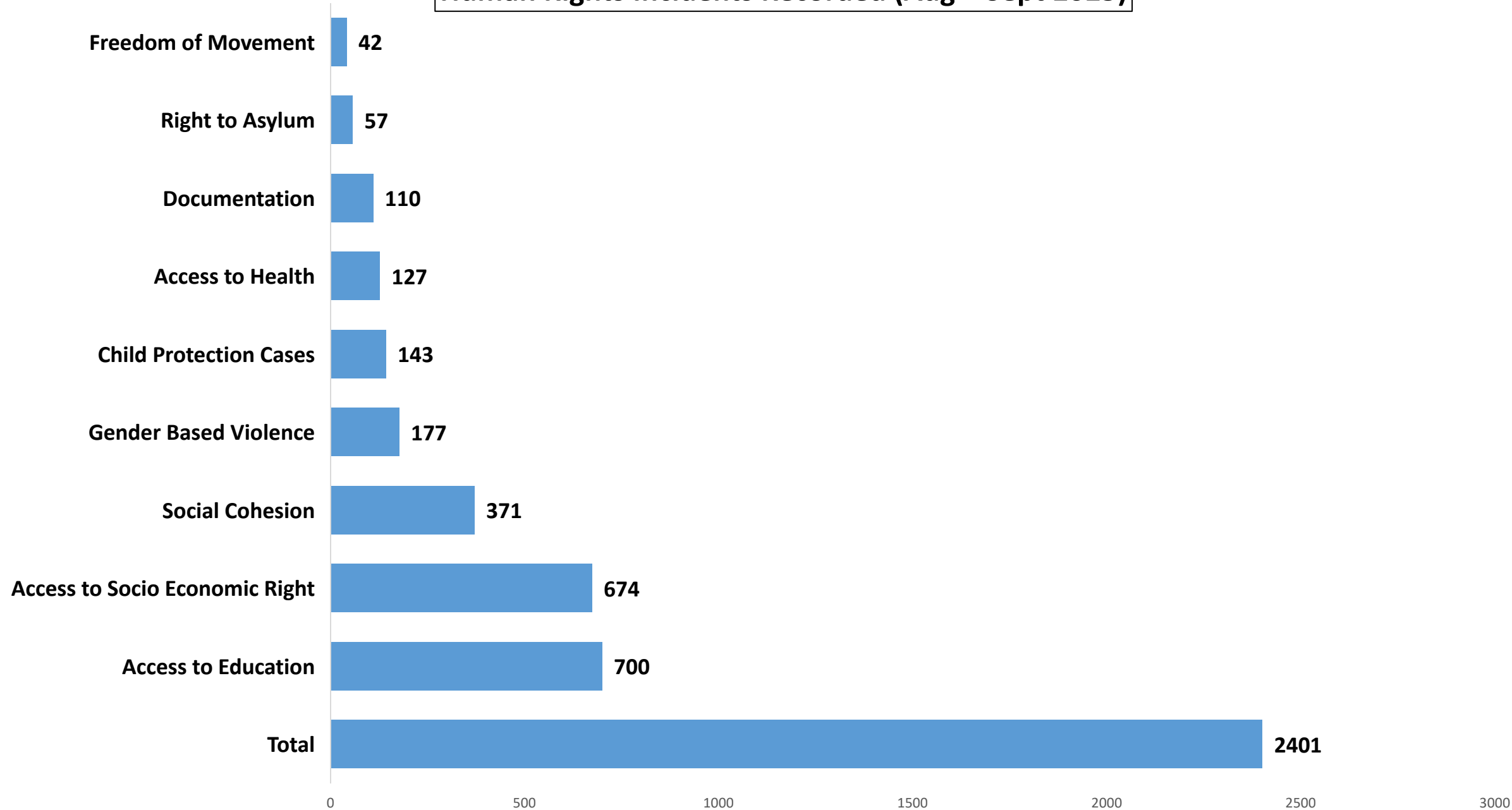

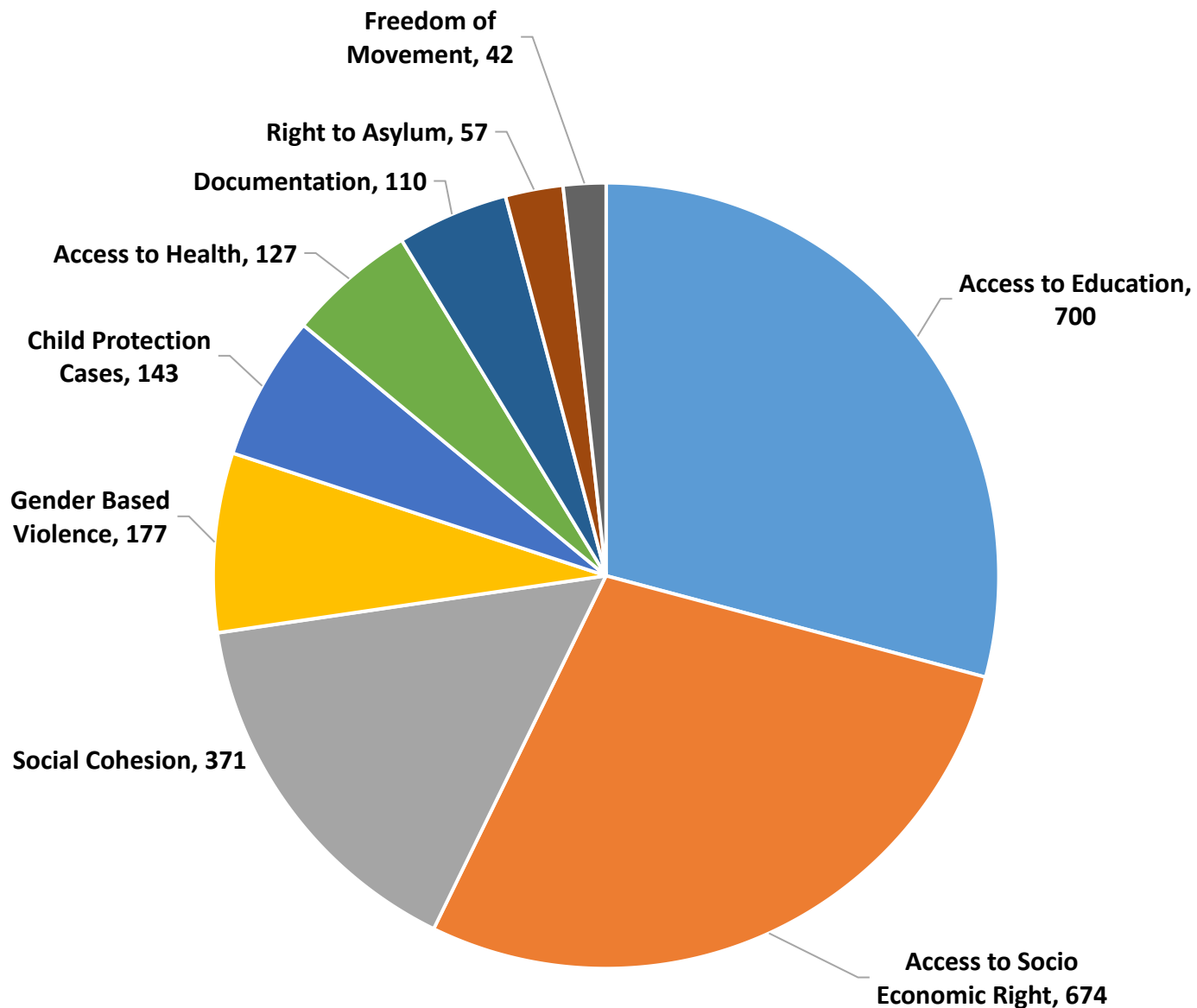

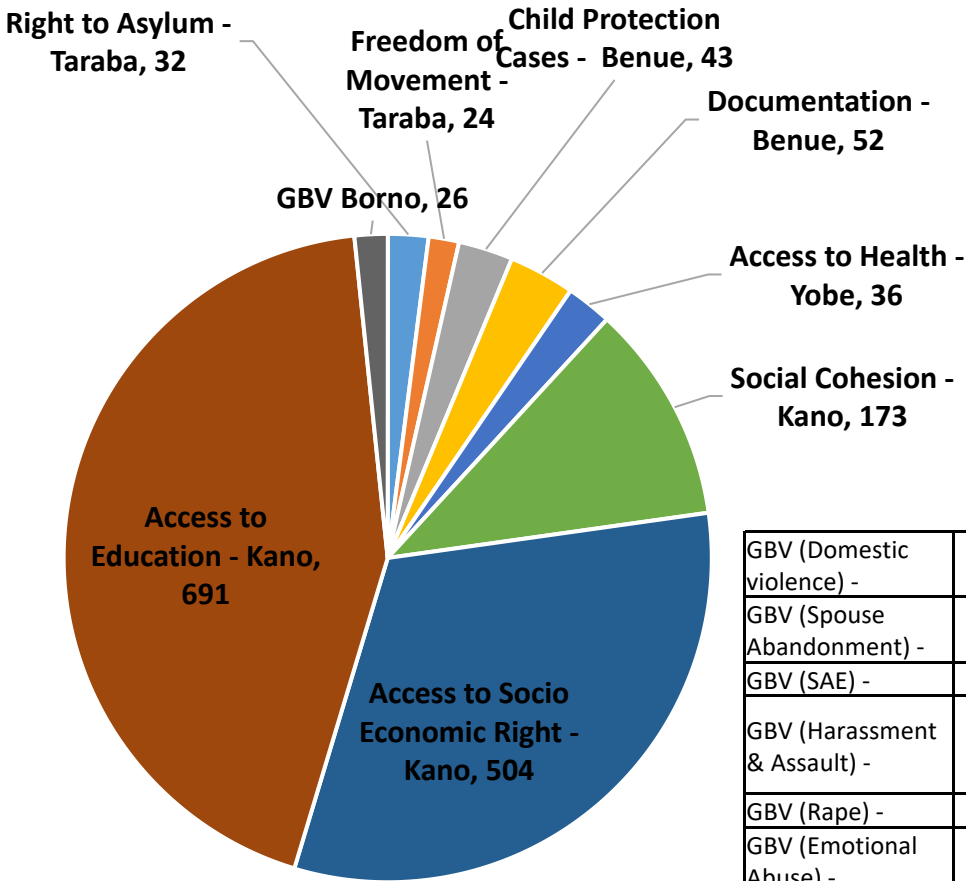


Human Rights Protection Incidents Recorded (Aug – Sept 2025)



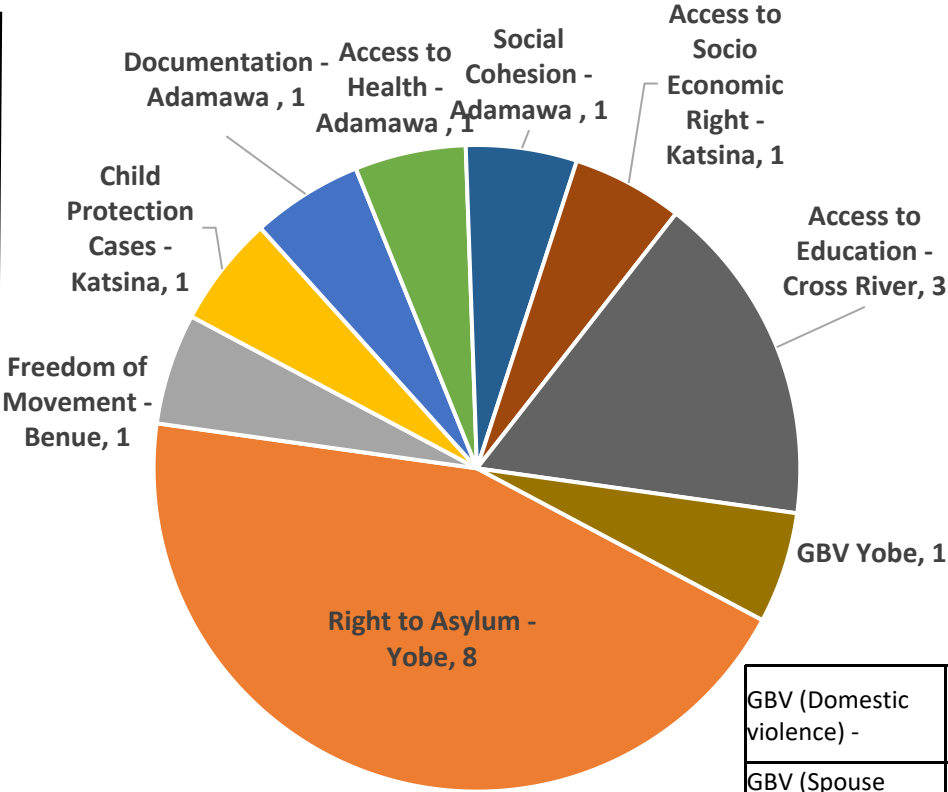

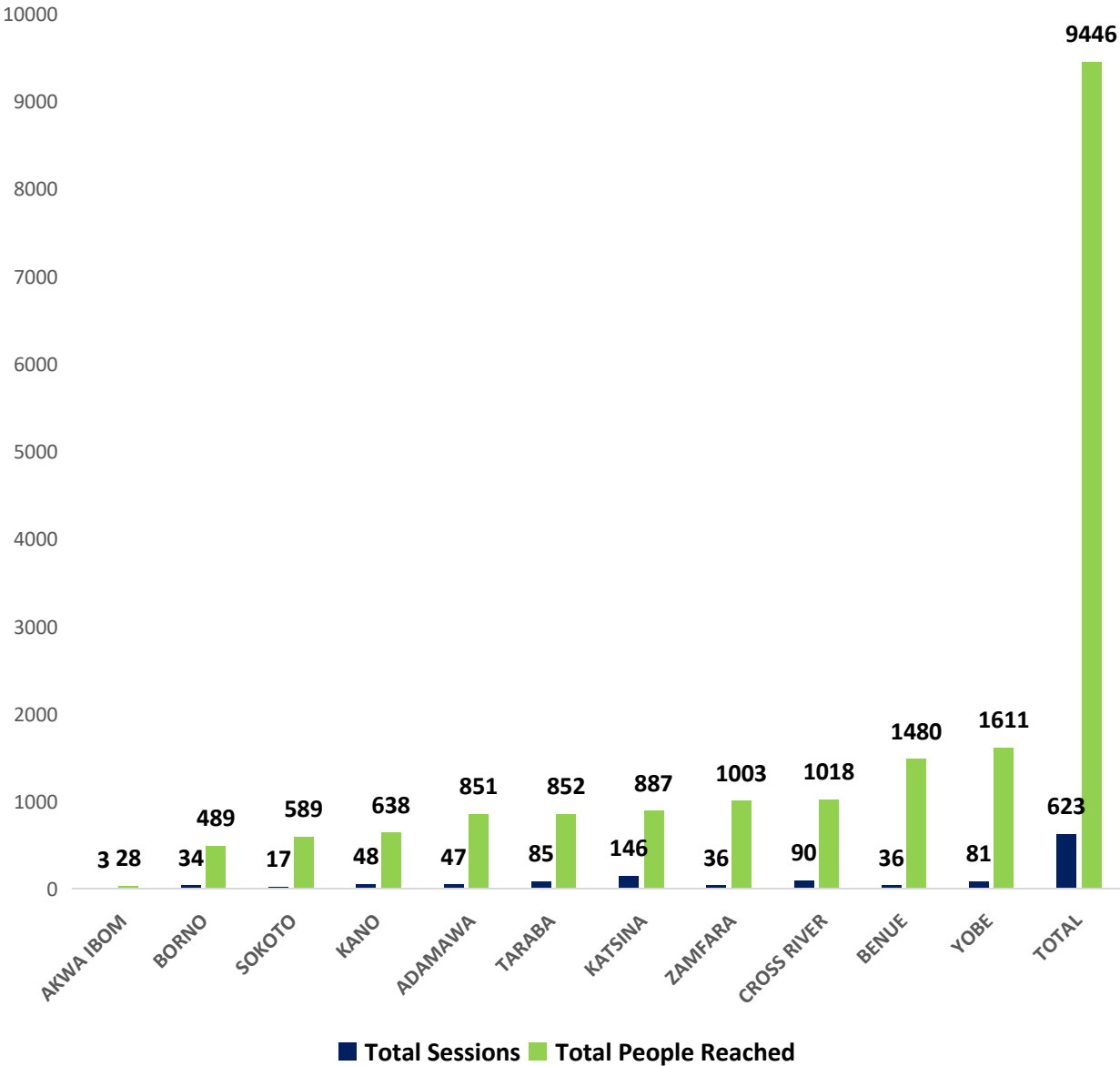

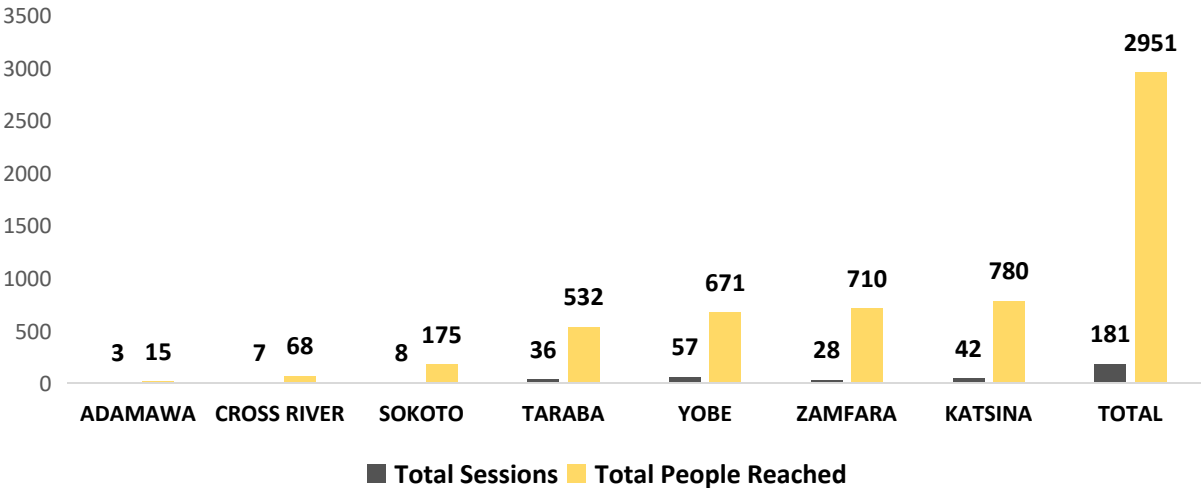

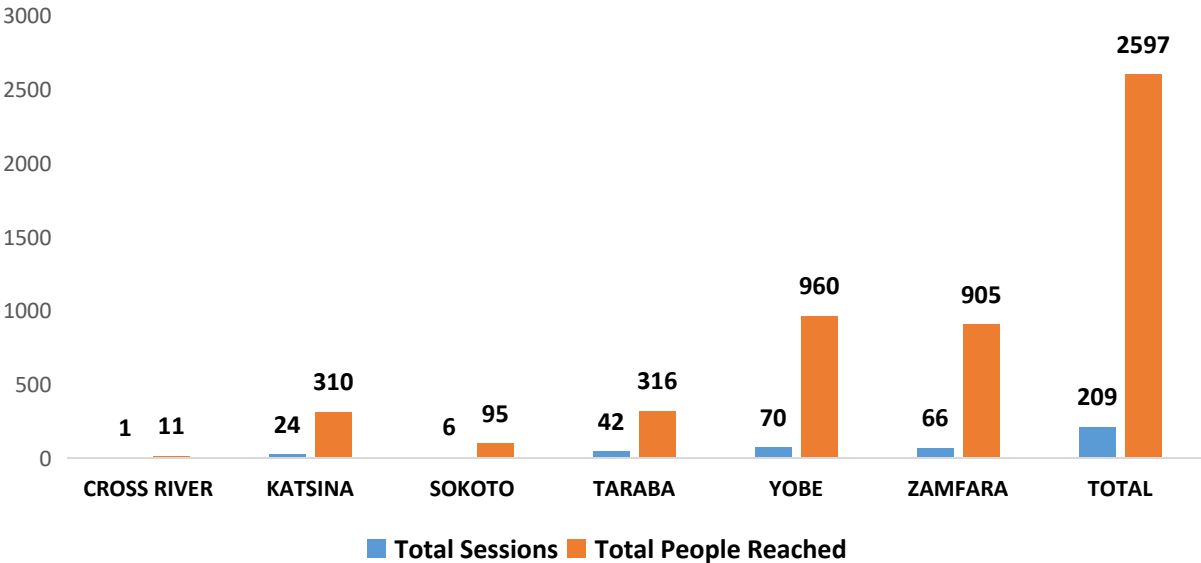

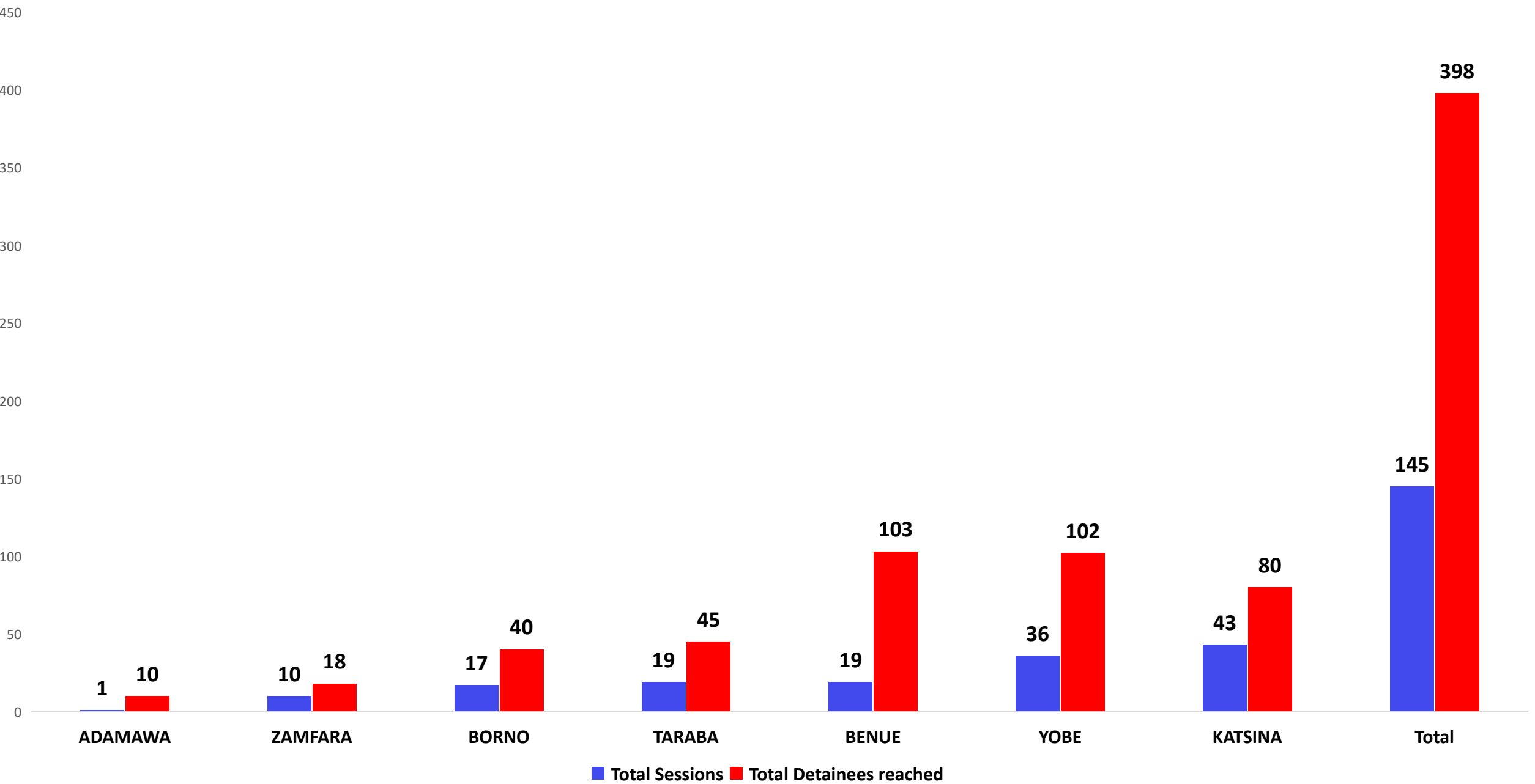

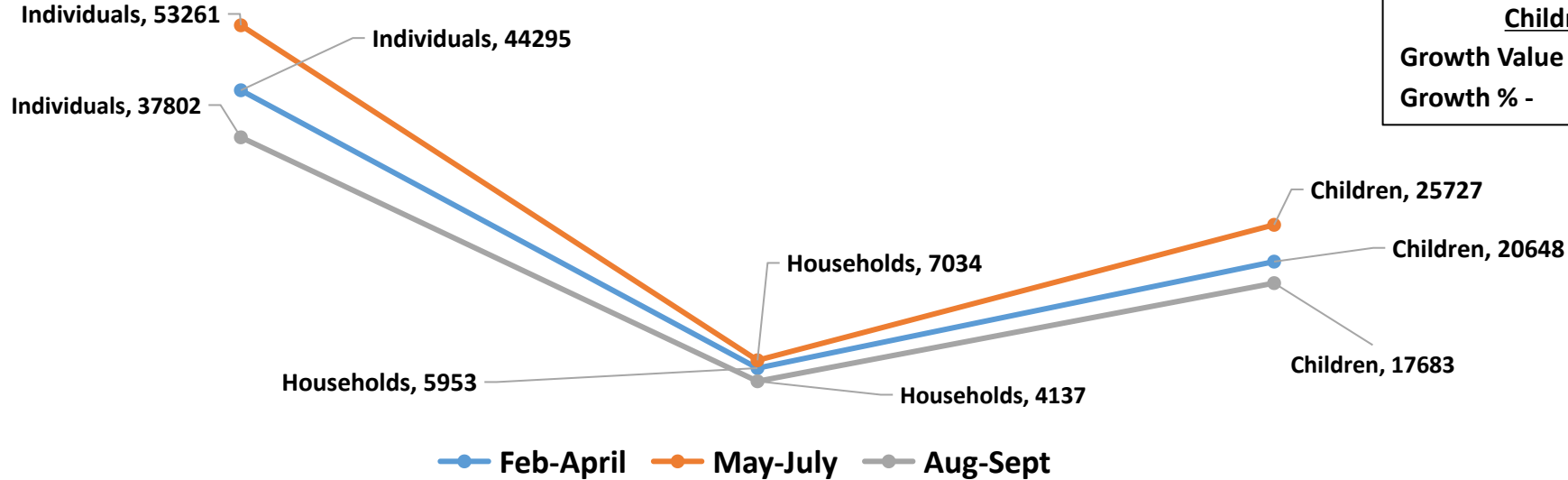

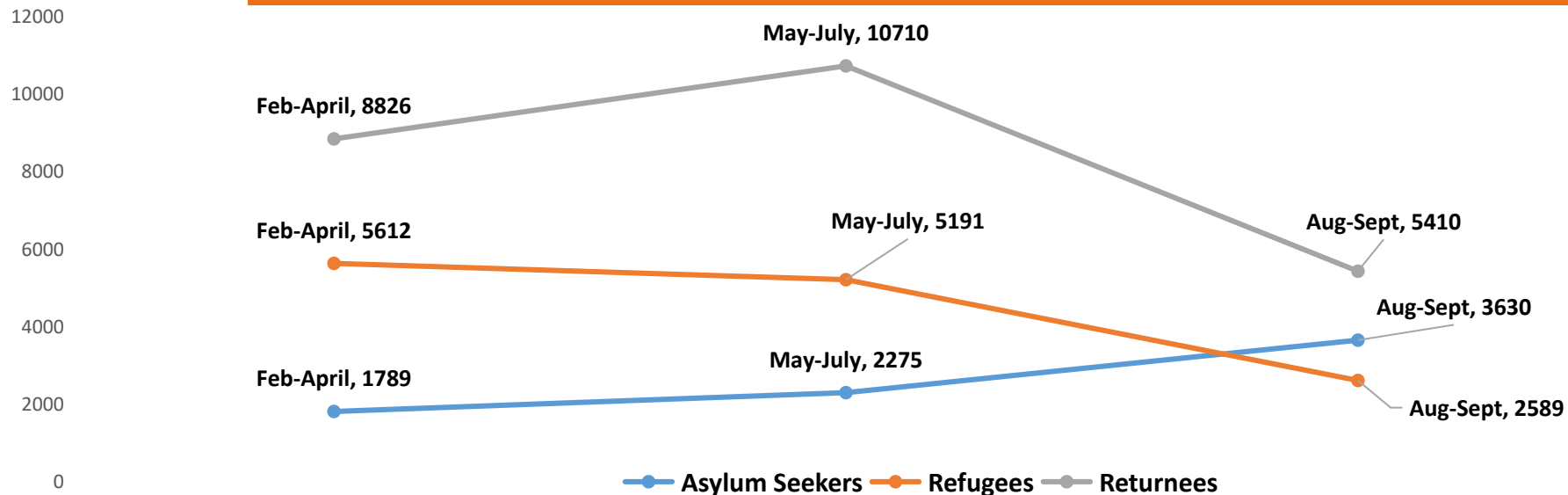

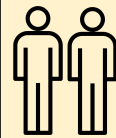

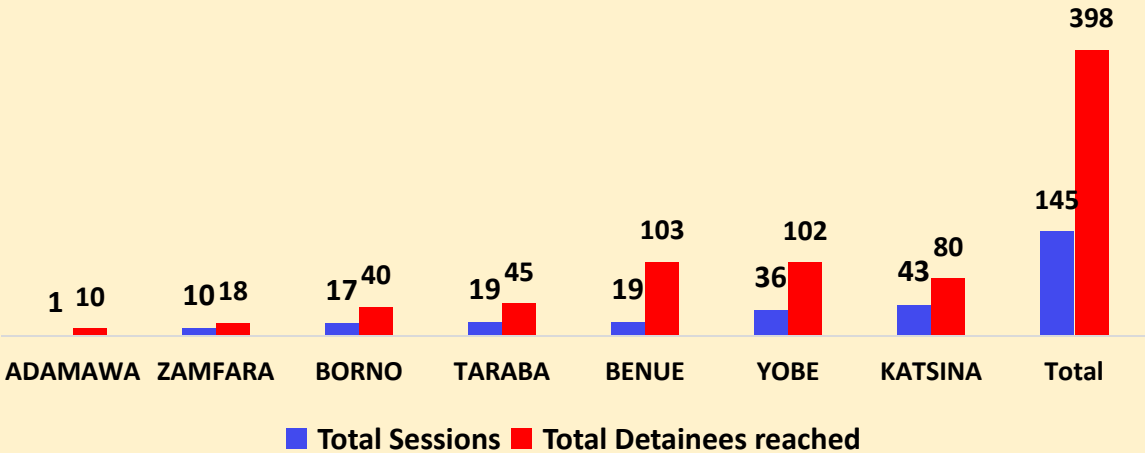

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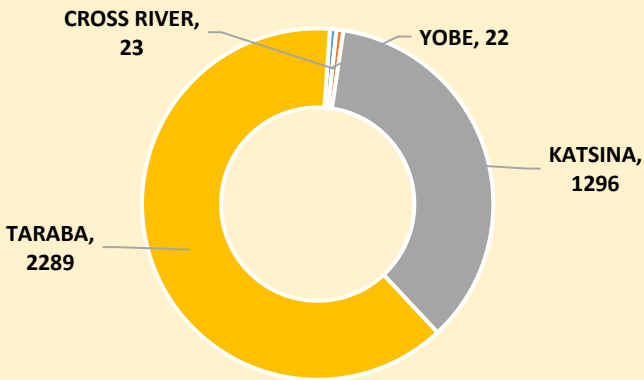
Detention Monitoring Visits To Detention Facilities (Aug - Sept 2025)



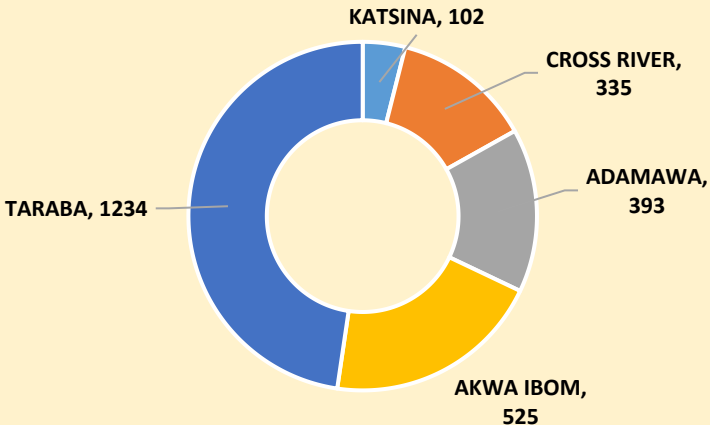
Total People Reached by Community Interventions



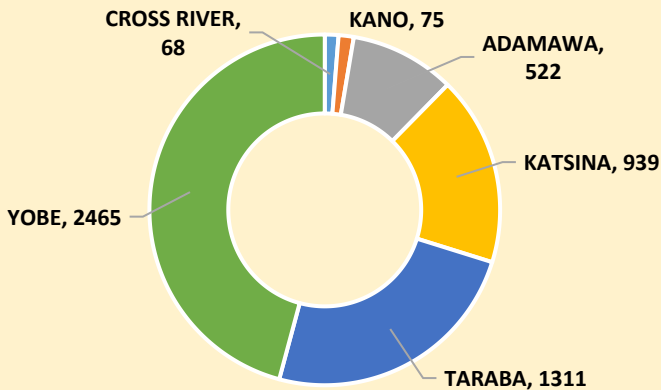
Total Asylum Seekers Aug – Sept 2025
